Polish and British Politics 2013: The Challenges and Opposition to the European Integration

The panel is to analyse the European policy-making of Poland from the British Perspective, as well as the Polish perception of key problems of the UK's European policy-making, and to compare these two perspectives.

Special attention shall be paid to the influence of the EU accession on the quality of Polish democracy as well as to the state of methodological debate and research in the field of studies on Euroscepticism. There shall also be discussed such important British political developments of the last year as influence of the Scottish independence debate on EU policy-making; perspectives of the UK's EU referendum; the 2013 Queen's Speech; and the legacy of Lady Thatcher assessed from the point of view of Central Europe.
